

## Twists and Turns of Picture Postage



The Banner Stamps appeared in the markets on January 28<sup>th</sup>, 1994. They featured a right and left facing 43 cent stamp with a special occasion background. 7 motifs, 35 centres in total, were included in the three-fold booklet. You choose a centre to put in the blank circle and presto -- you made a greeting stamp.

Leigh-Martin produced the 4<sup>th</sup> booklet as well. Now, January 15/97, the cover was yellow with blue, the stamps 45 cents and the paper Fasson. (woodfree special paper for off-set printing.)
